MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS – FROM CONSTITUTION

I. MEMBERSHIP

- I. Membership in the Society shall be open only to person, firms or corporations as follows:
 - a) GENERAL CONTRACTOR is a person, firm, or corporation who enters into a contract with an Owner and who, in performance of his work, hires other contractors. (This classification includes Management Contractors).
 - b) TRADE-CONTRACTOR is a person, firm, or corporation having a direct contract with a contractor to perform a part or parts of the work. (This classification shall include sub-sub-contractors).
 - c) MANUFACTURERS & SUPPLIERS is a person, firm, or corporation who supplies products to a construction project. (This classification includes Insurance Companies, Bonding Companies, etc.)
 - d) ASSOCIATE MEMBER: without voting privileges, is a person, firm, or corporation who acts in a supportive nature to businesses.
 - e) HONORARY MEMBER is an individual, where in the opinion of the Board of Directors, the person has distinguished himself/herself by service to the Association, the construction industry, or the community at large. Such membership shall carry no fees, dues, nor voting privileges.
 - f) PROFESSIONAL MEMBER: without voting privileges, is a person, firm, or corporation who is granted professional status through a specific professional organization.
